- object to data processing, in accordance with the provisions of GDPR;

- receive personal data provided to the Data Controller in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and transmit such data to another controller;
- lodge a complaint to the supervisory body The Inspector General for Personal Data Protection (Generalny Inspektor Ochrony Danych Osobowych, ul. Stawki 2, 00 - 193 Warsaw - if You find that your data is illegally processed.
- 8. I have the right to object to the processing of any and all personal data at any time. Such an objection does not affect the legality of data processing conducted prior to the objection.
